DAY KOLKATA TO CAIRO

Today you begin your journey by boarding your outbound flight to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo in the morning complete immigration and customs formalities. Then proceed for Egyptian Museum which contains relics dating back to 4000 BC. Here is a unique opportunity to survey the many fabulous treasures of Egypt in one place.

Later enjoy Lunch. After lunch check in to the hotel. Evening enjoy sound and light show at the Pyramids. Overnight in Cairo.

CAIRO - ALEXANDRIA - CAIRO DAY

After breakfast leave for a Full Day tour to Alexandria. Founded by Alexander the Great in 331BC, the city was home to the Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Our tour begins with a visit to The Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa one of the largest Roman burial sites in Egypt. Pompey's Pillar which is an incredible granite Roman triumphal column made between 298-303 AD to pay homage to the great Roman Emperor Diocletian. Finally visit on a low plateau east of central Alexandria overlooking a beach on the Mediterranean Sea. After tour return to Cairo.

DAY GREAT PYRAMIDS - SAQQARA - MEMPHIS - ASWAN (By Overnight Night Sleeper Train)

After breakfast we begin our day with a visit to the Pyramids at Giza. Home to the Great Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren and Mykerinos and the enduring and mysterious Great Sphinx. Later continue to visit the Saqqara area, where the stepped pyramid of Djoser is situated. This pyramid is significant because it was the first model for all the pyramids that came after it. Then we visit Memphis, where the statue of Ramses II is situated. Later evening we transfer to the railway station and board our first class sleeper train to Aswan. Dinner and overnight on board.

ASWAN - BOARDING NILE CRUISE DAY

We will detrain in Aswan in the morning. In ancient times, the town was legendary as the entrance to the kingdom of Nubia. Today it's still something of a frontier town. With its mixed population of Egyptians and Nubians, Aswan is quite unlike any other town in the country, and a fascinating place to visit. We begin with the visit to Philae Temple which was relocated by UNESCO to Aglika Island after it became evident that the original site of Philae would submerge on completion of the Aswan High Dam. It represents a magnificent and enduring testament to both ancient and modern engineering. After the tour, check in to your 5 Star Nile Cruise. Later in the day, we enjoy a sunset sail on a felucca, a traditional wooden sailing boat. Feluccas have been a fixture on the Nile River for centuries and are used in the protected waters of the Red Sea and eastern Mediterranean. The Felucca's deck is strewn with soft colourful cushions and rugs and equipped with a canopy that offers shade and protection.

DAY ASWAN - ABU SIMBLE - ASWAN - CRUISE CONTINUES

5 Today we visit Abu Simbel, 300 km. to the south through the Nubian Desert near the Sudanese Border. This tour will start at 04:00 hrs in the morning. A breakfast box is provided. Built by Ramses II the two temples are certainly some of the most spectacular in Egypt. Originally on the banks of the Nile, the temples were raised to a new site above the lake in the late 1960s, as the waters from the new Lake Nasser rose behind the Aswan High Dam. The four great seated statues of Ramses II stare east towards the rising sun. Later return to Cruise. Sail to Kom Ombo. The Temple of Sobek and Haroeris at Kom Ombo was dedicated to the crocodile god (Sobek) and falcon god (Haroeris). Later continuing our journey to Edfu which is where we will spend the night.

EDFU - ESNA LOCK - LUXOR - CRUISE CONTINUES DAY

Waking in Edfu, we start our day exploring the best-preserved cult temple in Egypt, Horus Temple in 6 Edfu before sailing further north along the Nile. After crossing the Esna lock we reach our destination Luxor, where we will have our final dinner on board and hopefully witness a stunning sunset over the river.

[Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]

DAY LUXOR - HURGHADA

After breakfast we disembark in Luxor and start our day visiting the Valley of the Kings. For nearly 500 years this was the site of royal burials and it contains the tombs of over 62 pharaohs. You will enter to Tutankhamen's Tomb which is included to our itinerary. After wards we visit the massive stone statues of the Colossi of of Memnon, then to mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was built by the architects of the New Kingdom Pharaoh Hatshepsut approximately in the 15th century BC. After Lunch, we visit the extraordinary Karnak and Luxor temples which both stand within the modern city of Luxor. Later we leave behind the green Nile valley and drive through the barren Eastern Desert to the Red Sea (approx. 5 hours). Our destination is Hurghada, a vibrant beach resort ideally located for activities out at sea. Overnight in Luxurious resort in Hurghada.

Today the day is free to relax or enjoy the many optional activities in the area. (Optional tours to experience the exquisite diving and snorkeling among the Red Sea coral reefs and see some amazing rare fish. DAY HURGHADA - CAIRO

9 After breakfast we drive back to Cairo. On reaching Cairo explore the old bazar of Khan-el-Khalili which is a great place to shop for souvenirs. The stalls are full of colourful lanterns, candles, jewellery, perfumes, musical instruments, and other handicrafts where you can pretty much find anything you could possibly want within its walls. Overnight stay at Cairo.
