# **Day wise Itinerary**

DAY KOLKATA TO VIENNA

Today you begin your journey by boarding your outbound flight to Vienna. Upon arrival in Vienna International Airport complete immigration & customs formalities, thenhave dinner in restaurant followed by check in to the hotel. Overnight stay in Vienna.

#### VIENNA - HALLSTATT - SALZBURG DAY

PRAGUE DAY

After breakfast, depart for Hallstatt which is a village on Lake Hallstatt's western shore in Austria's mountainous Salzkammergut region. Its 16th-century Alpine houses and alleyways are home to cafes and shops. We will enjoy both way cable car in Hallstatt including Skywalk & Welterbeblick. Then proceed towards Salzburg - the city of Sound of Music & birthplace of Mozart. Overnight stay in Salzburg.

### DAY SALZBURG - PRAGUE

This morning, before proceeding towards Prague, Enjoy a guided tour of Salzburg including "Sound of Music" tour, The Mirabell Gardens and Pegasus Fountain (dancing scene with Maria and the children) Leopoldskron Palace (where the family lived in the film) Hellbrunn Palace (song scenes)

Nonnberg Convent (where Maria lived as a young novice) etc.Next Proceed to Prague also known as Praha - capital and largest city of the Czech Republic.It is the fourteenth-largest city in the European Union. It is also thehistorical capital of Bohemia. Dinner & overnight in Prague.

#### [¶Breakfast, Light Lunch, Dinner]

Enjoy a half day guided city tour, including the beautiful St. Nikolas Church in the Old Town area with the Astronomical Clock, a stroll across the Charles Bridge to get a panoramic view if the city, Jewish Quarter (Josefov) located between the Old Town Square and the Vltava River. Spend some time in Wencasalas Square, located in the New Town Square which is the nightlife and entertainment centre of Prague. Dinner & Overnight stay at Prague.

## DAY PRAGUE - DRESDEN - BERLIN

After Breakfast proceed for Berlin. Enroute we will travel via Dresden, located in a valley on the River Elbe. In the 18th century, Dresden was a center of artistic activity which produced many of its iconic buildings. Allied bombing during World War II destroyed much of Dresden, but considerable restoration work has helped reconstruct some parts of historic Dresden. Enjoy a Short orientation tour including Semperoper, the Frauenkirche, Elbe and the Zwinger. Upon arrival in Berlin, checkin to hotel. Overnight in Berlin.

BERLIN - WARSAW DAY

[¶Breakfast, Light Lunch, Dinner]

Breakfast enjoy a guided city tour Berlin. Berlin, Germany's capital, dates to the 13th century.

Reminders of the city's turbulent 20th-century history include its Holocaust memorial and the Berlin Wall's graffitied remains. Divided during the Cold War, its 18th-century Brandenburg Gate has become a symbol of reunification. Including the tour we visit Berlin Wall, War Memorial (Neue Wache), Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag (Parliament), Gendarmenmarkt, Checkpoint Charlie. Later have dinner & overnight stay.

#### [¶Breakfast, Light Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast proceed to Warsaw the capital and largest city of Poland, an Alpha- global city, a major international tourist destination and an important economic hub in East-Central Europe. It is also known as the city of palaces, royal gardens, and grand parks. Upon arrival in Warsaw, Enjoy half day guided tour including Royal Route, Parliament, Lazienki Park with Palace on the Water, Old Orangery, Chopin's Monument & Belvedere Palace. Dinner overnight stay in Warsaw.

### DAY WARSAW-KRAKOW

After Breakfast proceed for guided tour of Auschwitz Concentration Camp including Birkenau Camp followed by guided tour of Krakow. Auschwitz Concentration Camp renamed as Auschwitz-Birkenau - Built by the Nazis as both a concentration and death camp, Auschwitz was the largest of the Nazi's camps and the most streamlined mass killing center ever created. It was at Auschwitz that 1.1 million people were murdered, mostly Jews. Auschwitz has become a symbol of death, the Holocaust, and the destruction of European Jewry. After completing Krakow City tour check in to hotel followed by Dinner in Hotel itself.

#### [¶Breakfast, Light Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast, proceed for the guided Wieiczka Salt Mine Tour, later enjoy a guided city tourincluding Jewish District of Kazimierz, Kanonicza & Grodzka Streets, Main Market Square, Chapel of St King and many more. Afternoon Evening is free for your own relaxation. Dinner & overnight in Krakow.

#### DAY KRAKOW - BUDAPEST

After breakfast proceed to Budapest - the most lively of Eastern European capitals and largest cities of Hungary. Straddling the Danube River, with the Buda Hills to the west and the Great Plain to the east, Budapest is a gem of a city. Upon arrival have dinner in restaurant followed by check in to hotel. Over night in Budapest.

After breakfast enjoy half day guided city tour including Buda Castle, Chain Bridge, Parliament, Castle District, Fishermen Bastion, Mathias Church, Central Market Hall, Heroes Square (photo stop), Evening enjoy Gypsy Show with dinner (Subject to availability). Overnight in Budapest.

#### DAY BUDAPEST - BRATISLAVA - VIENNA FLIGHT FOR KOLKATA

After breakfast, check out and proceed for Vienna, enroute we will cover orientation tour of Bratislava - capital of Slovakia & lying on the banks of Danube & Morava Rivers. Enjoy tour of the city including Monument of the Slovak National Uprising, following the traditional route of the coronation procession visiting the gothic St. Martin's Cathed Cathedral and Habsburg heritage sites. Later proceed for Vienna, upon arrival enjoy guided city tour of Vienna including Hofburg Imperial Palace, Belvedere Palace with entry to the Gardens of the immense Schön brunn Palace where visitors canstroll around and enjoy its beautiful gardens.
